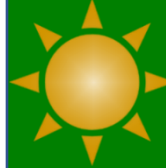

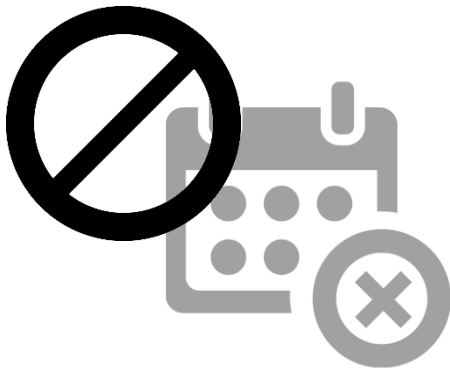

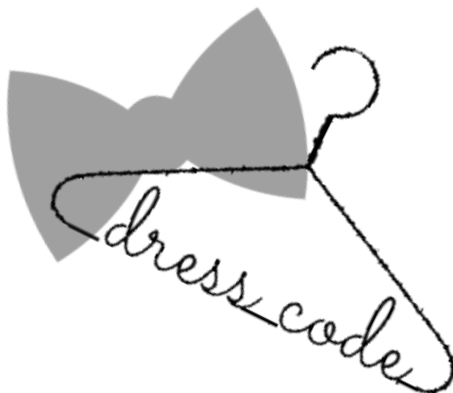
Parking is complimentary at the Holliday Inn and covered parking is available at The Senator.

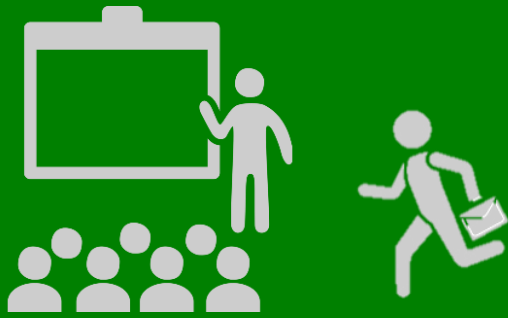


DRESS CODE

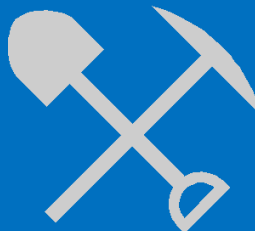
With plenty of sporty stops, including McIntyre Arena - a replica of the Maple Leaf Gardens, you'll see where Timmins hosts all their sporting events.
